# Apple Tree Special



## Northwest Greening

Heirloom variety producing large, pale green fruit that turn yellow when mature. Fruit keeps well, good for baking, especially pies, and sauces.

Zone 3

## Ida Red

Highly colored red apple. Excellent keeping qualities. Heavy annual bearer. Sweet-tart flavor, very juicy. Great for desserts and sauce.

Zone 4

## Golden Delicious

Best all purpose apple. Yellow color, early bearing. Mild sweet flavor, juicy & crisp. Excellent for eating fresh, baking, salads, & sauce.

Zone 4

## Red Delicious

Most popular of all red apples. Vigorous tree, heavy fruit production. Mildly sweet. Great for eating fresh & salads. Best in full sun location.

Zone 4

**Each tree: 4-6 feet tall 5/8 inch diameter \$20.00**

**POLLINATION:** The majority of apple trees are not self fertile, meaning that on their own, they cannot produce an apple. For most apple tree pollination to occur, one needs another variety planted nearby. Two trees of the same variety will not work. They must be of the same species (apple) but not the same variety. Note: A flowering crabapple tree will work as a cross pollinator for any apple tree, as it is in the apple family.
